- Abstracts of no more than 300 words should be submitted to the Administrator
- Themes of the Papers should be in line with the World Conference on Disaster Reduction and the Hyogo Framework for Action 2005 2015: Building the Resilience of Nations and Communities to Disasters which was held in Kobe, Japan, in 2005. The Conference heralded a major review of disasters and disaster reduction efforts. One of its main outcomes was the Hyogo Framework for Action 2005-2015, with 5 priorities for action:

Governance: ensure that disaster risk reduction is a national and local priority with strong institutional basis for implementation

Risk identification: identify, assess and monitor disaster risks and enhance early warning

Knowledge: use knowledge, innovation and education to build a culture of safety and resilience at all levels

Reducing the underlying risk factors

Strengthen disaster preparedness for effective response
